What is CV-SHARP



CV-SHARP Afloat:

- SIPRNET Web application
 - Captures Sub-Event (TAC) completions
 - Dictated in the CVN Training Manual
 - Reports to the SORTS part of DRRS-S
 - Reports to CV-SHARP Ashore
- CV-SHARP does not
 - Replace current training
 - Track PQS/Import to RADM





DRRS-S



- DRRS-S = Defense Readiness Reporting System – Strategic
- DRRS-S is the tool that DoD organizations use to report readiness to all levels of the chain of command
- DRRS-S requires two assessments
 - Missions (Standards, METs, and Core)
 - SORTS (Resources)



'P' credit grade is earned when the event is assessed (generally by an external agency using the associated Training and Assessment Card (TAC) and logged in CV-SHARP.

Adding Teams

Common Mistake when building teams: Once the team name have been entered, make sure the correct Team Type is associated with that team. For example; If you build a team named Air-Operations and link it to the Team Type of AC&R that will result in the wrong primary team for each sub-event Air OPS is responsible for. This will cause a severed degradation in the overall WARFARE AREA for the ship.



